- Tournament Name:** Alaska Rifle Club Conventional Prone Small Bore Summer Matches
- Date of Competition:** May 2, June 7, July 25, and September 20, 2009
- Sponsored by:** Alaska Rifle Club
- Directions to Range:** Matches will be held at the Birchwood Recreation and Shooting Park, which is North of Anchorage, Alaska. Take the Glenn Highway (Alaska Route 1) to North Birchwood Exit, go north on Birchwood Spur Road, passed Airport and Fire Station, turn at Birchwood Recreation and Shooting Park sign on right, go to the Rifle/Pistol ranges.
- Competition is open to:** Competition is open to all.
- Entry fee:** Entry fee is \$20.00 per iron aggregate and \$20.00 per any sight aggregate for each competitor. Those competitors wishing to entry both iron and any sight aggregate the cost will be \$25.00. A \$4.50 registration fee per competitor of the entry fee goes to the National Rifle Association. Junior competitors may join the Alaska Rifle Club for \$10.00 and shoot for free.
- Entries close:** Entries close at 10:00 AM at the Birchwood Recreation and Shooting Park the day of the competition.
- Post entries:** Post entries will be accepted on the day of the competition until the range capacity is filled. There will be a post entry fee of \$2.00.
- Entries:** Entries will be taken at the range beginning at 9:00 AM the day of the competition.
- Firing starts:** The first relay will be called to the firing line at 10:00 AM.

**Rules:**

Current NRA Small Bore Rifle rules will apply. Any rifle (rule 3.2), any sight (rule 3.7) will apply. NRA A-23 and A-27 targets will be used at 50 yards. The top bull's-eye is for sighting shots and 5 shots will be fired at each of the 4 record bulls eyes. NRA A-25 target will be used for 100 yards. The top bull's-eye is for sighting shots and 10 shots will be fired at each of the 2 record bulls eyes.

**Match schedule and conditions:**

The course of fire will consist of:

**Match 1:** 40 rounds prone, 50 yards, metallic sights, A-23/5 target, 1 minute/shot

**Match 2:** 40 rounds prone, 50 yards, metallic sights, A-27 target, 1 minute/shot

**Match 3:** Dewar Course , 20 rounds prone, 50 yards, any sights, A-23/5 target, 1 minute/shot; 20 rounds prone, 100 yards, any sight, A-25 target, 1 minute/shot

**Match 4:** 40 rounds prone, 50 yards, metallic sights, A-23/5 target, 1 minute/shot

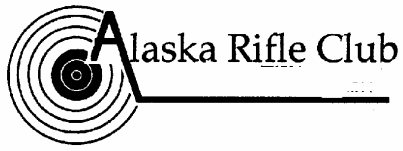
**Match 5:** Metallic Sights Aggregate -  
Total of matches 1 & 2

**Match 6:** Any Sights Aggregate -  
Total of matches 3 & 4

**Match 7:** Grand Aggregate  
Total of matches 1 through 4

**Classification:**

NRA classification will be used. If there are three or more unclassified competitors, there will be an unclassified class; other wise, unclassified shooters will shoot in the highest available class. There will be awards in each class unless there is only one shooter entered in a class, in which case he will be combined into the next higher class. If there is only one entry in Master, he will be eligible for OPEN awards only.

**Awards:**

Five NRA award points will be given to the overall winner of Match 5 & 6. Five NRA award points will be given to the High Woman and High Junior provided there are two competitors or more in these categories in Match 5 & 6. Awards will be given only for Match 5 & 6 as follows: three NRA award points will be given for the first place in each class provided there are two in the class. Second place will be given two NRA award points provided there are five entries in a class. Third place in a class will be given one award points provided there are ten or more competitors in the class. Five NRA award points will be given to the winner of match 7.

**General information:**

Competitors will be required to assist in setting up the range and changing targets. The nearest motel and state managed camping facilities are in Eagle River.
