- Tournament Name:** Alaska Rifle Club Small Bore Rifle Silhouette Match
- Dates of Competition:** January 24, February 28, March 28, April 25, May 30, June 27, July 18, September 26, November 21, December 19, 2009
- Sponsored by:** Alaska Rifle Club
- Directions to Range:** Matches will be held at the Birchwood Shooting Park, which is North of Anchorage, Alaska. Take the Glenn Highway (Alaska Route 1) to North Birchwood Exit, go north on Birchwood Spur Road, pass the Airport and Fire Station, turn in at Birchwood Recreation and Shooting Park sign on right, proceed to the Rifle/Pistol ranges.
- Competition is open to:** Competition is open to all.
- Entry fee:** Entry fee is \$15.00 for small bore silhouette rifle and \$15.00 for small bore hunting silhouette rifle. If the competitor elects to fire in both matches the fee will be \$25.00. If the competitor does not have a current NRA Small Bore Silhouette Rifle Classification book, he or she will be required to buy a book for the current price from the Statistical Officer.
- Entries close:** Entries close at 10:00 AM April through September and 11:00 AM October through March at the Birchwood Recreation and Shooting Park the day of the competition.
- Post entries:** Post entries will be accepted on the day of the competition until the range capacity is filled. There will be a post entry fee of \$2.00.
- Entries:** Entries will be taken at the range beginning at 9:00 AM the day of the competition.

## Firing starts:

The range will be open for practice from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM March through September and 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM October through February. The first relay for the silhouette rifle will be called to the firing line at 10:15 AM March through September and 11:15 AM October through February. Match start time for the Hunting Rifle Match will be 1:00 PM.

The time from the end of the Silhouette Rifle Match to 1:00 PM will be used for sighting in/practice or lunch.

## Cancellation:

Outdoor small bore rifle matches will not be held if at 10:00 AM the Ambient Temperature is less than +10° F. or if the wind chill is +1° F. based upon the weather conditions at the Birchwood Airport. Please refer to <http://weather.noaa.gov/weather/current/PABV.html>

## Rules:

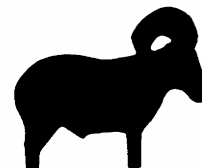
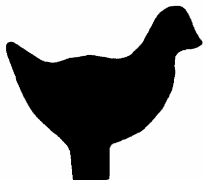
Current NRA Silhouette rules will apply.

## Match schedule and conditions:

The course of fire will consist of ten shots each on chickens at 40 meters, pigs at 60 meters, turkeys at 77 meters, and sheep at 100 meters. Each competitor will be required to score and set targets for one subsequent competitor.

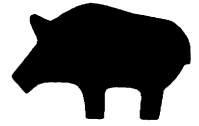
## Classification:

NRA classification will be used. If there are three or more unclassified competitor, there will be an unclassified class; other wise, unclassified shooters will shoot in the highest available class. There will be awards in each class unless there is only one shooter entered in a class, in which case he will be combined into the next higher class. If there is only one entry in Master, he will be eligible for open awards only.

**Awards:**

Ten NRA award points will be given to the OPEN winner. Five NRA award points will be given to the High Woman, High Junior and high light small bore silhouette rifle provided there are two competitors or more in these categories. Five NRA award points will be given for the first place in each class provided there are two competitors in the class. Second place will be given three NRA award points provided there are five entries in a class. Third place in a class will be given two award points provided there are eleven or more competitors in the class.

**General information:**

Competitors are urged to be prompt. The range closes at 10:00 PM. Potable water and lavatory facilities are available at the range. The nearest motel and state managed camping facilities are in Eagle River. Birchwood Shooting Park has some camping sites with hook ups.
