## 2020 Long Range Tournaments

**Capacity:** Maximum competitors: 21 (subject to COVID-19 restrictions)

**Dates:** August 22/23, 2020

**Location:** Colorado South Range, Ft. Greely, Alaska

**Directions:** Traveling South on the Richardson Highway from Delta Junction, go past the Rest Stop and the Power lines, you turn onto the second road (Wills Range RD) on your right (West side of highway). There will be a sign placed there.

Traveling North on the Richardson Highway you will pass the main gate to Ft. Greely on your right (East side of highway), and you turn left onto the next road (Wills Range RD) (West side of highway). There will be a sign placed there.

Go one mile (just past the fenced in area) to Colorado South Range (on the Right). Look to make sure the creek has not washed out the road into the range.

**Rules:** Current NRA rules will govern. Open Bolt Indicator, Hearing and Eye Protection are required!

**Eligibility:** Open to any ARC member. Non-ARC members must pay \$5 one-day membership fee.

**Pre-Register:** ALL competitors are required to pre-register beginning 2 weeks prior to the match, utilizing the link on the clubs' website. [www.akrifleclub.com](http://www.akrifleclub.com) . Walk-on participants may register on a space available, first come, first served basis

**Fees:** 2 Day Tournament Fee: \$20. (Includes NRA fee of \$4.50. Shooters under 18 are free)

**Entries Due:** 08:00 AM – 8:30 AM

**Start Times:** 09:30 AM

**Squadding:** Squadding assignment for individual matches will be issued during registration.

**Classification:** The NRA LR classification system will be used. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Assigned Classification (Rule 19.6), or Temporary Classification (Rule 19.2), may be used. BPTR and F-Class will use their LR classifications.

**Targets:** 1000 yard LR target. Competitors will be required to pull targets for other competitors.

**Rifles:** NRA Match Rifle (Rule 3.3), Service Rifle (Rule 3.1(a), 3.1(b), 3.1(c) or 3.1(d), Any Rifle/any sight (Rule 3.2) or Palma Rifle (Rule 3.3.3), or Rule 3.3.2 - NRA Any Sight Match Rifle/Tactical Rifle. Also Black Powder Target Rifle and F-Class (Open and TR).

### Sat. August 22, 2020 – NRA Approved Match

**Match A:** unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes prone slow fire at 800 yards LR target.

**Match B:** unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes prone slow fire at 900 yards LR target.

**Match C:** unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes prone slow fire at 1000 yards LR target.

**Match D:** Will consist of an aggregate of the three matches above.

**Note:** F-Class shooters will fire the same course as the HP Long-Range shooters, only they will use the F-Class targets and will fire either F-TR or F-Open with a Long-Range classification against other F-Class shooters only, and Rule 22 - F-CLASS RIFLE RULES will apply for them.

**Awards:** There must be 5 or more entries in a rifle category for one award, 8 or more for two awards; and 13 or more for three awards. Awards are paid by check mailed at end of season. 1st = \$10, 2nd = \$7, 3rd = \$4

**Open Awards:** Winners in Match D separately awarded for Categories: Prone, and F-Class

## Sun. August 23, 2020 – Fun Match

There are two firing berms behind the 1000 yard berm. They are at (or close to) 1000 meters and 1100 meters. On Sunday shooters will vote on two different courses of fire. Plan A will be 3 times at 1000 yards and Plan B will 1 time at each distance. We will shoot the Plan with the most votes.

### Plan A:

**Match A:** unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes prone slow fire at 1000 yards LR target.

**Match B:** unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes prone slow fire at 1000 yards LR target.

**Match C:** unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes prone slow fire at 1000 yards LR target.

**Match D:** Will consist of an aggregate of the three matches above.

### Plan B:

**Match A:** unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes prone slow fire at 1000 yards LR target.

**Match B:** unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes prone slow fire at 1000 meters (?) LR target.

**Match C:** unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes prone slow fire at 1100 meters (?) LR target.

**Match D:** Will consist of an aggregate of the three matches above.

**Note 1:** F-Class shooters will fire the same course as the HP Long-Range shooters, only they will use the F-Class targets and will fire either F-TR or F-Open with a Long-Range classification against other F-Class shooters only, and Rule 22 - F-CLASS RIFLE RULES will apply for them.

**Note 2:** The above matches on Sunday may be fired with 1 rifle for all matches, or a different rifle for each match. Rifle cannot be changed during an individual match except per the rules of a disabled rifle (9.1).

**Awards:** There must be 5 or more entries in a rifle category for one award, 8 or more for two awards; and 13 or more for three awards. Awards are paid by check mailed at end of season. 1st = \$10, 2nd = \$7, 3rd = \$4

**Open Awards:** Winners in Match D separately awarded for Categories: Prone, and F-Class
